## Knowledge Category Weight by Class Management

## Knowledge Category Weight by Class Key Terms

Blue Font indicates the Classes that are participating in the new Weight Knowledge.

Is unselected when the user enters the percentage for each Category. If not unchecked the user is gong to use the Traditional knowledge grading.

Percentage MUST equal 100\%

This field indicates the different categories the percentage, ID field, Program field, Course field, and a Class field.

Saves users percentage.
Clears the percentage for a class.

Copies the percentage of that class into the course.

## Knowledge Category Weight by Class Management

## ClassMate Weighted Knowledge Business Rules

When the standard MP closes, if you are set to "by MP" grading globally (In ClassMate Master Control)

- If you have graded activities (in Vocational type classes) in more than one class in the MP, or if you are missing a category (no graded activities in the MP for that category), it will revert back to standard, non-weighted, grading.
If you are set to "by Course" globally: (Or if MP Factor Override set to Course in the class setup in Instructional Course Offerings)
- If you have graded activities (in Vocational type classes) in more than one class within the course, or if you are missing a category (no graded activities in the MP for that category), it will revert back to standard, nonweighted, grading.

If set to "by Class" globally: (Or if MP Factor Override set to Class in Instructional Course Offerings)

- It will simply use whatever class is going to be graded (drop day rule) and weight if it can (if one of each activity is graded) if weighted is enabled on that class.


## For ACADEMIC MP closing:

- If you have graded activities in more than one course or class in a given program, or if you are missing a category (no graded activities in the MP for that category), it will revert back to standard, non-weighted, grading.

## Getting Started

Double Click Modules >Double click System Administrator > Click ClassMate Custom Control

1. Click the Grading Tab
2. Under the Knowledge area select the option that applies at your school:

- Select Integrated if your site uses Integrated Academics but no Weighted Knowledge Categories
- Selected Weighted if your sites uses Weighted Knowledge Categories but no Integrated Academics

## Knowledge Category Weights by Class Management

## Assigning Percentages to Categories

1. Click the Plus sign located next to the course. Note If the Font on the Course or Class is blue that means that the course is using Weighted Knowledge Categories instead of Default Knowledge Grading.
2. User must select a class from the list.
3. Uncheck (Use Default Knowledge Grading)
4. Enter a Percentage into the PCNT column for each category the class will be using.
5. The percentage total MUST equal $100 \%$

## Knowledge Category Weights by Class Management

## Copy Percentage by Course

1. Click on the Plus sign located next to the course.
2. Select the Class which has the percentage that going to be copied to the course.
3. Select Edit located on the toolbar.
4. Click on Copy Percentage by Course.
5. Click on Copy Percentage by Course.

- Users will receive a message stating (Do you want to copy the class percentage).
- When YES is selected the user will get a confirmation message.
- When the process is completed, notice that the font for the Course and Classes are BLUE. That informs the user that the course and classes are using Weighted Knowledge Categories instead of Default Knowledge Grading.




## Knowledge Category Weights by Class Management

## Clear Percentage by Class

1. Click the Plus sign located next to the course.

Note If the Font on the Course or Class is blue that means that the course is using Weighted Knowledge Categories instead of Default Knowledge Grading.
2. User must select a class from the field.
3. Click Edit located on the toolbar.
4. Click Clear Percentage by Class.

- Users will receive a message stating (Do you want to Clear all percentage).
- When YES is selected a confirmation message will appear.
