Learning Guide Key Terms

- **Purpose** Objective; Explain reason for and relevance of task
- **Exit Outcomes** Used to rate students' task performance
- **Support Objectives** Include Knowledge, Academic Concept, Anchors, and Skill Objectives
- **Knowledge** Assignments that assess students' understanding of concepts related to the task
- **Academic Concept** Standards and Anchors used for task instruction
- **Hands On Practice Skill**; Performance of the task and skills required
- **Special Materials** Resources and equipment required for task completion
- **Safety Factors** Practices and resources required to uphold safety standards
- **Learning Activities** Student assignments designed to enable students to master the task
- **Evaluation Criteria** Criteria used to rate student performance of the task
- **Academic Standards** Industry standards tied to the task
- **Academic Anchors** Clarify standards and focus on essential skills and knowledge required to meet academic standards
